So, we request parents to contact teacher (or vice versa) to set up a time (**about 10 to 15 minutes**) that is convenient to both parent and teacher, **any day between Friday, Oct 24th through Friday, Oct 31st.**

Parents need to complete a google form after the meeting is complete to indicate the meeting is complete. As mentioned earlier, this meeting is a required activity. This is to ensure that everyone has the same understanding of the child's learning progress and avoid any surprise later in the year with grades.

A few tips to have an effective meeting:

- Rather than specific questions on scores or individual homework, please take this time to discuss the child's progress overall thus far and what can be done in future. You can always contact teachers via email on specific questions on weekly homework, scores, or project work expectations.
- This is a good opportunity to discuss conversation topics for students to practice with you!
- If there are questions about students needing to take extended leave of absence, please contact Ramesh or Felix. There are specific policies related to that and we need to consistently apply those for all students always.
